**Constitutional Monarchy** – The monarch is a symbolic leader, and the Parliament makes the laws.




### History of Constitutional Monarchy

Magna Carta signed by King John in 1215.

### Monarch:



#### Constitution

British Constitution – A group of laws and court decision

#### Representative Legislature

- Located in London, England
- Made up of the House of Lords and the House of Commons
  \*\*Members are elected and appointed
- Head of the British Parliament Prime Minister, or the true head of the British government.

# What is the European Union?



#### European Union – 28 Nation Members

**European Union** – An organization of European nations that promotes free movement of goods and people across borders.

- No tariffs or taxes on goods imported from other member nations so goods move freely.
- The euro is the currency used in a majority of EU nations, Britain does not use the euro.
- The EU has own parliament
- The United Kingdom and Ireland are members of the European Union (EU)

## How does a country exit the EU?

Article 50 is a plan for any country that wishes to leave the EU.

They have two years to reach an agreement on the split.

It is a complicated process when there are years and years of treaties and agreements on thousands of subjects.
