
Review: Infrastructure

Zoning



Zoning

- Ways in which land in a city gets divided up and categorized.
- Zoning is one aspect of planning a city.

Zones

City Planners: Work with city officials, engineers, architects, lawyers and developers to create specific zones for how land will be used.

Zones fall into different categories.

Residential Zone

- Where people live
- Can be <u>high density</u> (What does high density housing mean?)
- Can be low density (What does low density housing mean?)



Commercial Zone

• Stores and restaurants



Industrial Zones

• Factories and power plants are located here.



Agricultural Zone

• Features farms and ranches.



Mixed Use Zones

- A blend of more than one zone.
